## IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR OUR CUSTOMERS

### Water reduction update

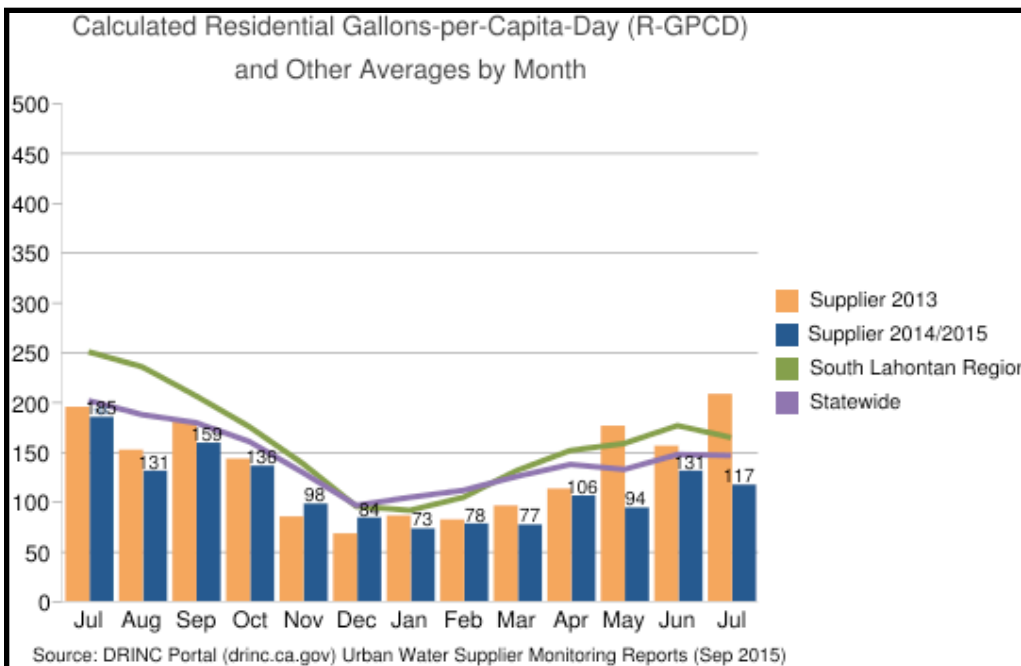
Our community continues to pull together, working towards the state mandated water use reduction goal of 28%.

The California State Water Board reported that our community had reduced our water use by 32.3% from our 2013 usage. On top of that great news, they also announced that we have reduced water use by 31.3% state-wide. This is clear evidence that our continued conservation efforts are working!

You can see, in the graph below, our community's hard work is paying off. Our

current usage (blue bars) has consistently been lower than our 2013 usage (orange bars). Our usage is even better than the region and state-wide averages (purple and green lines). Looking at April and later, you can really see the difference we have made conserving water when the State put out the initial calls for aggressive conservation. It truly is impressive what our community has accomplished by working together.

While our July numbers are great, we need to keep in mind that we are still in this historic drought. We should remember, as a community and state, that we must keep on conserving until our water supplies have stabilized and the drought is over.



**Stage 3 water conservation is still in effect and being enforced.** Please continue to be vigilant in your efforts to conserve around your home and in your reports of water leaks and water waste.

Making it through this historic drought is a big thing, and we have proven that we can do it, together.

## Questions about water use

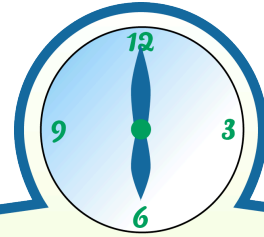
We have recently received questions about water use and restrictions. Here are some answers to those questions, according to the stage 3 water restrictions:

### Where can I get a copy of the stage 3 water restrictions?

### When can I wash my car?

You may wash your car at home on Saturday, Sunday and Monday, between 5pm and 7pm, using a positive shut-off hose nozzle. You may wash your car at a commercial car wash any day or time.

### Even address

Wednesdays  
Saturdays

## When can I water my lawn?

*The days you can water your lawn depends on your address. If your address ends in an even number, you can water on Sunday and Thursday. If it ends in an odd number, Wednesday and Saturday. On allowed days, you may only water between 6pm and 6am.*
