D1. Intern Program Development Planning (Presenter Kim Domingo)

GM Domingo explained that the purpose of today's meeting is to discuss implementing a summer intern-career program as a way to provide recent high school graduates who may be interested in trades or vocational education an introduction to careers in the water and wastewater industry.

Mr. Notterman and Mr. Tinich from Rosamond High School (RHS) will serve as the District's contact for the program.

The program will require students be a minimum age of 18 when the internship program begins in mid-June 2026 and possess a high school diploma and be eligible to work in the United States. RCSD will need to vet the program with District's legal counsel.

A tour of the District's Public Works, Wastewater Plant and Customer Service departments is planned in May. The school district will provide transportation for the tour. A RSCD waiver of liability will be required from all tour participants.

The RHS representatives will select a maximum of 12 students to participate in the tour, along with their parent(s) or guardian(s). Students interested in applying for the program will be required to participate in the selection process by completing a job application and participate in an interview conducted by RCSD staff.

Only one student will be selected to participate in the career intern program and must meet all the employment requirements of RCSD in order to be eligible.
