CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order at 3:00 PM by committee Chair President Wood.

DISCUSSION

D 1. Capital Project Update. (Presenter Kim Domingo)

GM Domingo provided a recap of the sewer side CIP budget list. He discussed the following sewer budget items:

Digital Phone System

Board Room Upgrade

Headworks

Grit Removal Expansion – it is undersized and will be done prior to the Headworks project.

Sludge Drying Beds – completed.

Sludge Dewatering

Monitoring Wells Construction – has compliance issues.

Apple Blossom Lift Station – will need to rethink existing plans.

Scada Upgrade

Mechanical Re-roof

HVAC Replacement – Ben will follow up with John Houghton for bid information.

GIS Upgrade

Office Remodel – Ben to follow up

Sewer Camera

Windows 11 Upgrade – completed

Backhoe – purchased

Security Fence – Ryan has reached out to a fencing company for cost information

Sewer Replacement Project (collapsed line) - Will go out to bid.

D 2. Industrial Waste Program Draft. (Presenter Kim Domingo)

AGM Stewart presented a copy of the program plan draft to the committee. He discussed that the purpose of the plan is to keep the Wastewater Plant running optimally and avoiding upsets by incorporating source control, which will ultimately result in keeping sewer rates as low as possible.

The draft is a work in progress and incorporates a combination of plans from the cities of Lancaster and Palmdale.

D 3. Sewer Pipe Standard Draft. (Presenter Kim Domingo)

GM Domingo informed the committee that the Sewer Pipe Standard is a work in progress. The two types of pipe to consider is PVC and vitrified clay pipe (VCP). VCP is more expensive of the two.

D 4. PFAS Regulatory Update. (Presenter Kim Domingo)

GM Domingo informed the committee that there is no real update available at this time. Existing information indicates that PFAS can be detected in human bodies.

There has been a push by regulators to quantify this however there has not yet been a study that says it impacts health.

PFAS is detectable in human waste and ends up in our wastewater, but it is not in our water supply. However our District still needs to be concerned about this and we are required to test for it. We need to understand the destruction process in our wastewater. Solutions like reverse osmosis and micro filtration can be very expensive.

GM Domingo feels there will not be a solution for another 5 years. The District staff will continue to monitor this issue and report back to the committee periodically as new information becomes available.


GM Domingo also informed the committee that required information regarding Chromium 6 content in our water will be mailed to our customers after the first of the year. The District has exceeded the newly regulated contaminant level.
