PUBLIC COMMENTS

DISCUSSION

D 1. Potential Water Purchase Update (Presenter Kim Domingo)

In the last discussion, projections for demand did not present a compelling reason to consider purchasing the additional 300 AF of water.

GM Domingo explained we are reconsidering the proposed 300 acre-foot per year purchase due to questions about the purpose of water acquisition fees that are charged to developers. He will work with the District's finance consultant to see if these fees can be used to pay down development costs at the Wastewater Treatment Plant . The sellers of the water have been contacted to let them know the District is reconsidering the purchase.

GM Domingo will update the board on the water purchase reconsideration in his report at the next regular board meeting.

D 2. Existing and Proposed Capital Projects Review. (Presenter Kim Domingo)

Highlights discussed:

Chromium 6 Project – compliance timeline is September 2027. Staff is looking at a few different technologies in addition to considering leasing a well that has good water quality and produces 2500 GPM for blending purposes. AECOM has been tasked with developing a blending study to see what the results would look like. Their study proposal will be presented to the board for approval possibly by next month. Another update will be provided once the study is completed.

Myrtle & Melvin Water Line Replacement Project – The GM will present the Myrtle and Melvin pipeline replacement project bid award at Wednesday's board meeting. It is under budget.

Well Recoat Project – will involve needed repair. Design will be finalized and sent out to bid.

D 3. DWR - SB 1157(2021-2022) Post Workshop Discussion - (Presenter Kim Domingo)

a. Review Goals of Workshop - Urban Water Use Objective.

Background: Requires the DWR in conjunction with the State Water Resources Control Board to include collaboration and input from stakeholders to conduct necessary studies and investigations with the goal of formulating a standard for indoor residential water use.

b. Ideas regarding 2030 goal objective – goal objective is 42 gallons per person per day:

1) Offering rebates for low-flow toilets. GM to determine the impact on low flow toilet replacement for the next committee meeting to help evaluate 2030 water conservation goals.

2) Address Metron meter initiative in mid-year budget to consider installing meters for all 5,300+ connections. Metron registers will be helpful in reporting water use data. Promote customer use of the Metron Meter Water Scope website.

3) Have assigned Directors present conservation messages and district initiatives at RMAC and Chamber of Commerce meetings.

4) Provide information on leak detection.

D 4. Future Items:

Director Wood will provide additional conservation ideas at the next committee meeting.


