



**ROSAMOND COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT IS

PUBLIC WORKS OPERATOR I – FULL TIME**

Rosamond Community Services District provides water, sewer, street lighting, and graffiti abatement services to approximately 5,000 customers. Rosamond is located in Kern County, 80 miles north of Los Angeles.

**The Position:** This position, Public Works Operator I, performs a variety of semi-skilled and skilled duties in the inspection, installation, maintenance and repair of the sewer collection system, and performs a variety of tasks relative to assigned area of responsibility. This is the entry level in class series. At this level, incumbents learn and perform a limited range of the less complex or specialized work tasks, under closer supervision, with less latitude for independent action. Duties may include; cleaning sewer lines and siphons using hydro-jetters and winch brake trucks with bags, balls or hoes; raising or lowering manholes to grade; entering sewer structures through manholes to clean, inspect and repair as needed; may assist in excavation and reconstruction of broken sections of sewers; construct and repair piping systems working with steel, PVC, polyethylene and galvanized pipes of various sizes; operate mobile equipment such as tractors, loaders and light trucks; perform limited welding; respond to emergency repair calls; and perform related duties as required. This position may also assist with the installation and repairs of water mains, fire hydrants, check valves and water service lines; taps water mains; performs ground excavation work; mixes, rakes, and spreads asphalt, and patches and/or repairs excavations. (These examples do not cover all duties which may be assigned.)

**Qualifications:** High school diploma or general education degree (GED); and at least one (1) year experience in the installation, repair, and maintenance of water services, mains, meters, valves, hydrants, and related facilities or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience. Possession of, or ability to obtain within 1 year of appointment, a valid D1 Water Distribution System Operator Certificate issued by the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) is required. May be required to obtain a higher grade as job requires. Valid Class C California driver's license and a satisfactory driving record.
